# THE WASINI DHOW TOUR

In the early morning we will pick you up from your Holiday Home, this is normally around 6.30 am. The drive takes around 1hr from Diani to Shimoni using the Mombasa to Tanzania highway. On the way you get to see the culture of the people and also sugarcane plantations. Since we don't take many guests (max.12 Person on Naval and 16 on double the size Dhow Babul ) on our tours, you will be most of the time the first guests in the Kisite Marine Nationalpark. That gives us the advantage of spotting dolphins before all other Dhows arrive there.



Upon arrival to Shimoni you go pick your park fee tickets, then you go on our traditional Arabic dhow called "Babul" or "Naval". There you meet our captain, 2 crew members and a tour guide who give you the program of the day as you enjoy your refreshing Swahili breakfast which includes coffee/tea, fruits , bhajia and mandazi.

Our Dhow Waswila then goes to Kisite Marine Park where you enjoy a personalized and professional snorkeling (or diving for a small extra cost) experience graced by the presence of dolphins, sea turtles, octopus, lobster, grupper fish, trumpet fish, moorena fish, stingrays, star fish and many more. Please don't forget that the Kisite Marine Park isn't a Zoo – so we can't guarantee all the fishes, but be sure that our crew is professional trained and they will do their best for a perfect day for you. You get to snorkel in two different locations of Kisite Marine Park where you get to see the beauty of the coral reefs and much more. From the park you can clearly see Tanzania.

...and that's why we have an underwater camera that will take photos and videos for FREE throughout the day. In the evening our manager will upload them on Dropbox and after your request via facebook ([www.fb.com/dianidhow](https://www.facebook.com/dianidhow)), via email ([hello@dianidhow.com](mailto:hello@dianidhow.com)) or WhatsApp (+254 (0)720 637773) he will send you the download link. From here you sail (if the wind conditions allow us) back to Wasini Island for lunch as you relax on our spacious dhow listening to our or your (you can bring an usb stick with your favorite songs) music and having some cold beverages.

When you get to the island you get a delicious fresh Swahili sea food lunch with their king crabs, there is an option of vegetarian food or chicken incase one doesn't eat sea food. We offer two glasses of wine or two beers – and for sure all non-alcoholic drinks are FREE during the day too.



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When you get to the mainland you go to the Slave Caves. There you learn more about the history of Kenyans and what they went through during colonialism. THEN YOU DRIVE BACK TO YOUR HOTEL.....

# About Wasini/ Kiste Marine Nationalpark

Wasini Island lies southeast of Kenya opposite the harbour of the village Shimoni. It is app. 7 kilometres long and 3 kilometres across. Kisite-Mpunguti Marine National Park is situated on the southern coast of Kenya near Shimoni and south of Wasini Island in Kwale District near the Tanzanian border. Kisite park covers 11 square kilometres while Mpunguti reserve covers 28 square kilometres. The park covers an area with four small islands surrounded by coral reef.



## **Snorkel & Dolphin Watching Tours**

All tours include hotel transfer (from Diani beach), boat trip, if lucky dolphin watching, snorkelling in the Marine park, lunch, quick tour of the village on the island and back. Some say: "It's all the same", but that's NOT true! You can book this tours either with your touroperator, in most local Travel Agencies or Safari Offices, on the beach or with "Diani Dhow". Each tour is quite different in their package or quality of service. Please compare proper before you book - Our Motto is: "Price is an issue only in the absence of value."

# Why Diani Dhow?

Diani Dhow takes only 6-12 guests per trip – even if our dhow is licensed for 24 pax.

That brings a lot of advantages like ...

1. We are almost always the first in the Marine park, since we don't have to pick up too many guests from different locations. This is why at that time we often see dolphins ...
2. You have more space for yourself – you can sit comfortable or lay down and have a nap.
3. If our captain sees dolphins during your snorkel stop – it's easier for us to pick you and bring you straight to them which is the main reason for you to go for that trip (it's very difficult or impossible if you have 30 snorkelers in the water).
4. You will get more attention from our 2 Snorkel guides – so best for not so experienced snorkelers, kids or guests who need just a little help here and there.
5. If you are a small group – it's easier to decide to lengthen or shorten this or that part of the trip.
6. Most of the time you will be alone in our restaurant – hence it's not so crowded like other places.

## Snorkeling/Diving

1. We have latest snorkel equipment – even Full Face Mask and prescription diving masks.
2. You can dive with us for a little extra fee of 35 Euro – Best even for Fundivers/Beginners!
3. We do 2 Snorkel Stops (each 45-60 minutes) with a break in between.

## Lunch

1. SeaFood lunch or Chicken /Vegeterian Food for lunch which is always yammy.
2. We also offer you 2 beers or 2 glasses of white wine for lunch – FREE!

## What else is Special with us?

1. We do have a Nikon 4k Underwater Camera on board and our Crew takes amazing photos and videosfor you. In the evening Steffen will send you a Dropbox link for FREE download!
2. Free entrance in Coral/Mangrove Garden (normally 200kes) on Wasini and the famous Slave Cave in Shimoni (normally 400 kes). Means even with Diani Dhow you will support the local community there – we call that “Responsible Tourism”.
